

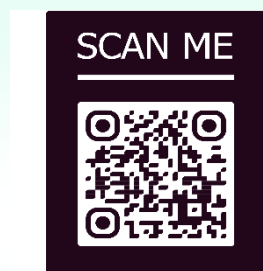

It suggests thorough inquiry and a commitment to science, where the researcher examines the facts more carefully in order to learn all that can be learned about the topic at hand. The creation of high-quality research literature is significantly influenced by publication ethics. Lack of understanding among authors, pressure to publish for financial gain, professional progress, and lack of monitoring and control procedures are the main causes of publishing misconduct.


